## OUR VISION:

A society in which adults and children with disabilities and severe illnesses are able to maximise their quality of life through social and travel opportunities.

## OUR AIM:

To make travel possible for those who by reason for their disabilities or illnesses find most means of transport impossible to contemplate.

## HOW DO WE DO THIS?:

The Jumbulance Trust is a small Charitable Trust with 4 unique specialist vehicles, part coach part ambulance, which are specifically designed and equipped to make it possible for those who are disabled or very ill to travel throughout the UK and Europe on holiday or Pilgrimage. Each "Jumbulance" as we call them, can accommodate a maximum of 10-12 disabled or ill people accompanied by a carer plus Nurses or Doctors if required.

## **The unique and special features include:**

**Wide platform lift for ease of access, fully adjustable trolley beds, reclining seats with extra leg room, spacious wheelchair accessible toilet/washroom, comprehensive emergency medical equipment including: heart start and suction units, oxygen etc, galley kitchen for preparing small meals and drinks, generous storage for wheelchairs and luggage, mobile hoist, PA System, air conditioning**



## HOW CAN YOU HELP?:

1. We aim to subsidise the true cost of operating the Jumbulances by about 20% to make it affordable to those who can benefit from them, most of whom have limited means due to their condition. This subsidy amounts to some £35,000 a year, for which we are dependent on the generosity of our supporters. For example, £1,800 would help fund a group of 24 on a 10 day holiday.
2. We have recently purchased a new Jumbulance built by Van Hool to our special requirements to replace one of our existing 20 years old vehicles but we urgently need to replace one other. The cost will be in the region of £250,000 -400,000 excluding specialist medical equipment.
